Institute of architecture and urban&spatial planning

The Institute of Architecture and Urban & Spatial Planning of Serbia (IAUS) was established in 1954 and is independent scientific research organization with the aim to deal both on research and as work on comprehensive projects in the field of architecture and spatial/urban planning. IAUS's professional work is carried out within three organizational units: Center for Architecture and Housing, Center for Spatial Development and Environment, and Center for Information Technology, Publishing Activities and Education. The Institute has 40 full-time permanent employees of various professional orientations (30 of which are holders of scientific, research or professional titles). It also gathers many visiting associates - experts in specific fields.

IAUS has achieved noticeable results in the scientific and research work. It has a status of state-owned institution. Fields of expertise fall within the government competence and include the so-called public sector (urban planning, spatial planning, environmental planning, landscape planning, water management, etc), and also covers some commercialized activities (investment projects, environmental assessments, utility industry, waste management projects, etc). IAUS is the only institute in the Republic which is accredited for scientific work in the field of architecture, urban and spatial planning. The Institute has been leading institution and partner in several international scientific projects (FP7 project, project financed by the World Bank, Swedish government etc.) and leading institution in more than 15 national projects. In most of the European countries, there are institutes that most often operate on public funding and are less often privately-owned.

Specialties:urban, regional and spatial planning (Spatial plan of the Republic of Serbia and Spatial plan of the Republic of Montenegro), planning of special purpose areas (waterways, national parks, protected areas, mountain regions, Danube international waterway corridor, infrastructural corridors, multicriteria location analysis, waste management and landfill planning, water management, development of methodology for implementation of European development documents, conventions and guidelines within Serbian planning (the Action plan and Guidelines for the European Landscape Convention implementation in Serbia in the preparation), environmental protection, sustainable spatial development of the Danube Plain in Serbia, publishing activities and education etc.
