1) PROJECT INFORMATION

Field of expertise related to the topic:

Established in 1991, Wissenschaftsladen Wien - Science Shop Vienna is an independent interdisciplinary research institute that performs research in response to the needs and demands of non-profit organisations, such as human rights organisations, non-profit service organisations, local





authorities and social or environmental initiatives. As a research-based CSO located in Europe's largest self-governed cultural centre we are deeply rooted in civil society and have "street credibility" among civil society organisations.

The interdisciplinary team has a long time experience in organising public participation and mediation between academia and practitioners. Its expertise covers the whole range of empirical social scientific research and the whole lifecycle of public and stakeholder engagement: from design to implementation and documentation, even on a large scale. All team members participate in FP projects since FP5. Almost all of our FP projects were funded under the umbrella of the Science with and for Society Work Programme.

Supported by a Scientific Advisory Board, the Science Shop Vienna is a member of the Living Knowledge Network - the International Science Shop Network -, the Federation of Austrian Scientific Societies (VWGÖ), and the Alliance for Responsible Science.

Social scientific research:

The Science Shop Vienna has worked on a broad range of topics such as citizen science, gender action plans, science communication, knowledge transfer, disability issues, housing, the situation of student moms, internet communication, employment policy and science policy. Quite often the Science Shop Vienna pioneers research topics and approaches. The experienced team has profound knowledge of a broad variety of methodological skills in quantitative and qualitative research. Just to name a few:

- Designing and conducting qualitative surveys
- Conducting expert interviews and Delphi studies
- Conducting qualitative interviews and group discussions with users, consumers and other target groups
- Scenario techniques

Public engagement and stakeholder involvement:

The expertise of the Science Shop Vienna covers its whole lifecycle: from design to implementation and documentation. Latest achievement: the co-ordination of 35 matched scenario workshops in 13 countries. We reach out beyond those frequently participating in consultations.

The team of the Science Shop Vienna combines the above mentioned skills and approaches to methodologies perfectly tailored to the transdisciplinary design of SwafS projects. The Science Shop Vienna is a perfect partner for organisations following a design thinking approach.

RRI:

Except governance - we are not policy makers -, the Science Shop Vienna has expertise on all key action points named by the European Commission - public engagement, gender equality, science education, open access, and ethics, resp. research integrity - and builds its research projects on the four RRI dimensions anticipation, reflexivity, inclusion, and responsiveness.

Other expert knowledge:

Adult education and school teaching: Two team members are experienced adult education trainers, one of them has a certification for secondary school teaching.

Ethics and research integrity: One team member has expertise on moral philosophy and is co-founder of an international research network on research integrity, media and evaluation.
