Since 2008, the Accademia has developed a widely recognized and highly successful annual series of events that brings international scientists to the small village of Gagliato, population 400, in Calabria, Italy. In parallel with the discussions of the multidisciplinary think tank devoted to advances in nanomedicine, NanoPiccola holds its International Conference, attended over the last 6 years by several hundred children between the ages of 5 and 18.		
NanoPiccola's annual conference comprises educational activities centered on the nanosciences, including games, presentations, trading cards, and a Q&A session with the scientists. This lively and successful program has been developed in conjunction with the NanoDays series developed by the NISE (Nanoscale Informal Science Education) Network.
